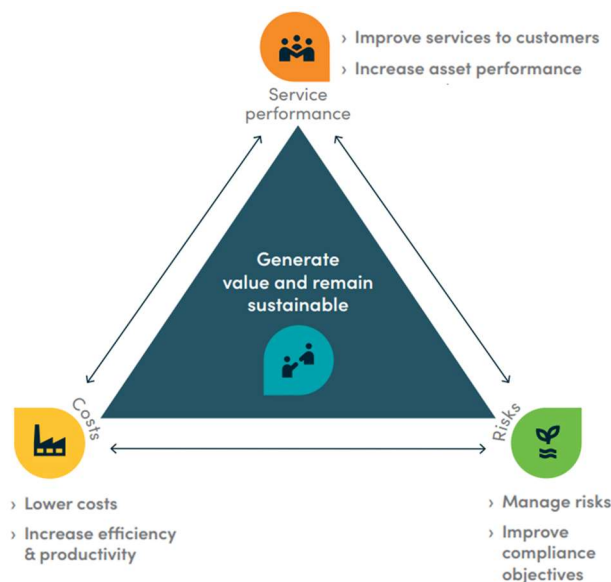


## Objective

## Responsibilities

The Chief Executive Officer is responsible for implementation of this Asset Management Policy.

The General Manager Sustainable Infrastructure Services is the owner of the AMS and is responsible for reporting to Executive Management and the Board on asset management performance.
